





Prior to the event, the Society accepts donations that will then be sold. These include smaller furniture, clothing and jewelry, kitchen and household, toys, tools and hardware items, fabrics and crafts, stationary, books and dvd's (please no VHS tapes), smaller sporting goods, collectables and vintage items.

The sale is a major fundraiser for the Society, which uses the money for the benefit of the Historic Village at the back of the fairgrounds.

The 'Fun in the Ville' is being held at the Rotary Centennial Park in Fowlerville on Saturday, June 8, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Vendors will offer arts, crafts, and baked goods. The Fowlerville United Brethren Church will be back with their Kids Games Tent, while the Army National Guard will be on hand with several bounce houses to play on. There will also be a Petting Zoo and a Bike Raffle for the kids.

Fowlerville Family Fair July 22-27

The Fowlerville Family Fair, scheduled July 22-27, offers Grandstand entertainment, midway rides and games, youth livestock and still exhibit competitions, and plenty of food and refreshments.

Grandstand evening shows include: Harness Racing on Monday night, Figure 8 Demolition Races on Tuesday, Bump & Run Demolition Derby on Tuesday, Bump & Run Demolition Derby on Wednesday, Thumb Tractor Pull on Thursday, and the Lost Nations Rodeo on both Friday and Saturday.

Other highlights include Harness Racing on Tuesday afternoon, Horsepulling Competition on Thursday afternoon, and Draft Horse Shows on Friday and Saturday morning.

The midway will be provided by Skerbeck Entertainment Group and runs from Tuesday thru Saturday. Special Youth Show events include the Large Animal Market Livestock Auction on Friday and the Small Animal Market Livestock Auction and Still Life Exhibit Auction both on Saturday. The Fair Queen Contest and the Livingston County Homemaker of the Year are held on Monday afternoon, and Kids Day takes place on Wednesday.

The Circus will make a stop at the Fowlerville Fairgrounds on Saturday, August 3, and Sunday, August 4. There'll be two shows per day, with Saturday's at 3pm and 6pm and Sunday's at 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. The circus features ponies, horses, and camels, along with fabulous aerial, juggling, and clown acts, with the show lasting about 90 minutes. Souvenirs are available as well, including a Pages Circus Coloring Book.



Vet Fest *August 10*

Vet Fest will be held at the Fowlerville Fairgrounds on Saturday, August 10, from 12 noon to 4 p.m. It is put on by VETLIFE, a non-profit organization, with an office in Livingston County.

The event is free to all veterans and their families, as well as active duty military members. It features food, bounce houses, live music, backpack and school supply giveaways, and lots of resource information. All active military along with veterans in attendance were also eligible to win a wide variety of prizes.



Easy Riders Bike Rodeo August 16-17-18

The Easy Riders Bike Rodeo returns to the Fowlerville Fairgrounds for its annual three-day run—Friday and Saturday and Sunday August 16-17-18. Different weekend camping options are offered, depending on how long you wish to stay, as well as daily admission. Show hours are Friday 12 noon-1 a.m., Saturday, 9 a.m.-1 a.m., and Sunday 9 a.m.-1 2 noon.

Live entertainment, classic motorcycle rally games, and several different contests and competitions. No one under the age of 18 is admitted.

The breakfast was later taken over by the local Rotary Club. In 1970 the fly-in was switched to Maple Grove Airfield, located north of town—the year that facility was opened.

Livingston Centre Historic Village Fall Fest September 14

The Livingston Centre Historic Village, inside the Fowlerville Fairgrounds, will be hosting the annual Fall Fest on Saturday, Sept. 14, 11:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

There will be craft and food vendors, Barrel Train Rides, Kids' Games, Wagon Rides, as well as Live Entertainment. The model train inside the Pere Marquette Depot will be running throughout the day.

Tours of the buildings that make up the Historic Village will be continual throughout the day and are offered as part of the admission fee. Some tours will be self-guided like the 1910 Hartland Barber Shop and the 1870 Clinton Shoe Repair & Harness Shop from Pinckney, moved to the Village in 1991 and 1992, respectively.

Other structures will have docents that can share the stories of these artifacts of Livingston County. This includes the Kirkland House, built in 1859, and the Coughran Country School.

All proceeds from the Fall Fest fundraiser go towards the restoration, maintenance, and upkeep of the Historical Village buildings and grounds.






