## Village of Fowlerville Residents-Reminder: Brush Collection Ending for the Season:

The last pick up for Brush and branches (NO lumber materials) will be **November 8, 2022**

The brush must be stacked in the same direction, parallel to the curb (see example picture above) and no more than 5' from the roadside. Branches should be no longer than 4 feet and between 1 and 6 inches in diameter.

[Twigs and smaller branches need to be bagged and put out in the brown yard/compost bags for regularly scheduled pick-up on Mondays.] Please note: this service is not for tree removal debris.

Please have brush out by the residence curb by 7:00 AM, no sooner than three (3) days prior to the scheduled pick-up date.

The brush should not be piled on or around vehicles, fire hydrants or over utilities, such as curb stops/meter pits or AT&T junction boxes. Thank you for your efforts and cooperation.
